



The Wakaya Club & Spa is an intimate luxury resort on a picture perfect private island paradise in the South Pacific waters surrounding Fiji. Just 28 guests at any time are invited to partake in this all-inclusive atmosphere, where everything from the organic delicacies at dinner to water sports is included. Private beach picnics, golf, couple's spa treatments and more round out this heavenly hideaway highly lauded for its attention to detail and barefoot elegance.



Location

A tiny dot of an island in the midst of the South Pacific, Wakaya lies in the heart of Fiji, a nation made up of 333 islands located 1,500 miles from the coast of Australia. Tropical and idyllic, it spans 2,200 acres of pristine beaches, ocean, lagoons, and cliffs and is part of the Lomaiviti Group situated in the Koro Sea due east of Viti Levu. Guests land at Nadi International Airport, and then are transferred to Wakaya's own private luxury aircraft. From Nadi, it is a 40-minute flight to Wakaya, and transfer service is also available from Nausori Airport, a 15-minute flight.

Accommodations

The Wakaya Club & Spa is comprised of ten free-standing waterfront Fijian cottage suites or bures (pronounced boo-rays), feature cathedral ceilings, woven bamboo wall coverings and indigenous yaka timber flooring. Amenities include Champagne upon arrival, bowl of fresh local fruit, toiletries including 15 SPF sunscreen, CD player with a selection of CD's, air conditioning, high-speed wireless Internet connection, and iPod stations.

Ocean View Bure (7) and Garden View Bure (1)

Each 1650 square foot Bure is a luxurious hideaway located just steps from the Pacific Ocean, seven Bures feature Ocean Views, and one enjoys a garden view.

By design, Ocean View Bures and Garden View Bures are not equipped with televisions or telephones, except for an intercom to contact Reception. All Bures feature a secluded rear garden and two covered outdoor decks; bedroom with ample closet space and four-poster king size bed clad in the finest Fili D'Oro 100% cotton sheets from Italy; bathroom with oversized soaking tub, two vanities, open-air, lava rock shower and separate W.C. and bidet; gracious living room with wet bar; and a double-hammock.



Governor's Bure

The Governor's Bure offers 2,400 square feet of luxury and privacy for those who want a bit more space than in the Ocean View Bures. This elegant hideaway, named for Fiji's first British Governor who lived across the water in the old capital of Levuka, is a secluded retreat equipped to provide every conceivable comfort. The Governor's Bure is a stone's throw from the marina, where scuba diving and fishing expeditions depart, and enjoys a sandy beach in front of the bure.

The Bure features two large covered outdoor decks and a secluded garden with waterfall; oversized bedroom with vast closet space and four-poster king size bed clad in the finest Fili D'Oro 100% cotton sheets from Italy; sumptuous



bathroom suite with Jacuzzi bathtub, two vanities, open-air lava rock shower and separate W.C. and bidet; gracious living room replete with antiques from the Far East; entertainment center including bar, television for DVD viewing, and CD player with a collection of CD's and DVD's.

Ambassadors Bure

The Ambassador's Bure is an ocean front 4,500 square foot 2-bedroom retreat, designed for a maximum of two



couples or four people. Bure features a two treatment room spa complete with a secluded and covered Plunge/Water Shiatsu Pool Lanai; separate living room with a kitchen/dining area; Satellite TV, DVD and stereo system with surround sound. Each of the two bedrooms feature a four-poster king bed, spacious walk-in closet, writing desk, luxuriously appointed bathroom, including two separate vanities, a private outdoor shower, generous soaking tub—designed for two—and separate W.C. with bidet. A white sandy beachfront is just steps away.

Vale O

Vale O, or “House in the Clouds,” is the royal suite: a 12,000 square foot villa on a 16-acre hilltop estate with stunning panoramic ocean views. This three-bedroom villa is an air-conditioned retreat that offers complete privacy and attentive personal service for a maximum of three couples (or six people, including children). Vale O is a five minute drive from the resort, and comes with its own chauffeur, chef, full-service staff, tennis court, and pool.



Overlooking the Koro Sea and Homestead Bay (the island’s longest white sand beach), Vale O superbly melds western comfort with eastern serenity, showcasing the beauty of the island and the art and culture of the South Pacific. The property features a rock-rimmed pool with a waterfall and Jacuzzi, a night-lit tennis court, and a Boules court. Vale O features satellite TV, DVD and stereo system with surround sound. The spacious living/dining pavilion featuring Clarence House fabrics, the Gilmour’s personal collection of Asian antiques and wraparound decks with unforgettable views of the South Pacific. All three rooms feature king beds with the finest Fili D’Oro 100% cotton sheets from Italy. The master bedroom pavilion features two baths and separate dressing rooms, and the separate two-bedroom guest pavilion each enjoys an en suite bathroom.



Dining

On Wakaya Island, the notion of locally grown, organic produce is a “given”. Our kitchen, headed by Chef Marielle Hajj, specializes in Pacific Rim fare, inspired by the Island’s plentiful resources, including locally raised venison, pork, lamb, chickens and their freshly laid eggs. Seafood includes lobster, shrimp, local crab, tuna, wahoo, walu and mahimahi. Organic gardens produce micro-greens, herbs, several varieties of lettuce, eggplant, Chinese cabbage, avocados, kumquats, limes, lemons, pineapples, papayas, soursop, guava and Fijian ginger. Also included as part of the stay, enjoy beverages that include regional wines, freshly squeezed juices and tonics, coconut water, cocktails and soothing tea made from Wakaya Perfection Organic Ginger hand-cultivated in a virgin volcanic soil in Wakaya’s private paddocks.

Activities

Scuba or snorkel the marine-preserve directly in front of your Bure, or explore some of the world’s most beautiful reefs. Explore the island by hiking and guided nature walks, and enjoy a variety of water sports including stand-up paddle boarding, and kayaking. Other activities include:

Nightly rates are based on double occupancy and include "meet and greet" service at Nadi International Airport, guaranteed early morning check-in and late afternoon check-out (which amounts to 2 nights without charge), all meals and beverages (alcoholic and nonalcoholic), unlimited use of the fully stocked mini bar, unlimited wireless Internet access, personal laundry service, two scuba tank dives per person per day (Monday through Saturday only), and unlimited use of all other sporting facilities and equipment including golf, tennis, snorkeling, sea kayaking, Fitness Bure, and croquet.
